Leadership Learning Opportunity

The Alberta Museums Association is excited to announce a partnership with [Leaders of Tomorrow Canada](#) to offer one complimentary registration to an Individual Member of the AMA for the **November 24 - 29, 2024** offering at the Crossing at Ghost Lake near Cochrane, AB. This opportunity is supported by the AMA Board of Directors to give a leader in the museum community the chance to learn alongside leaders from the NGO community.

Leaders of Tomorrow Canada is a unique opportunity to learn, to grow, and to experience personal and professional growth.

- Training program focussing on leadership development and issues and opportunities unique to the non-profit sectors across Canada.
- A year-long self-development program, which begins with an orientation session and a four-day intensive experiential learning training followed by a monthly coaching / mentoring engagement for one year.
- The participants will progress through their own individualized leadership program, with the help and support of dedicated mentors.
- The culmination of the program includes a Leadership Summit, conducted one year after the initial leadership training.

Individuals interested in attending Leaders of Tomorrow Canada must meet the following criteria:

- Individual Member of the AMA in good standing (active membership)
- Able to attend sessions in-person beginning at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 24, 2024 and running from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily through November 29, 2024.
- Provide their own transportation to and from the Crossing at Ghost Lake
- Agree to write a 750-word article on their experience in the program for publication by the AMA on one of their digital platforms (e.g. e-newsletter or website).

The Leaders of Tomorrow Canada Program is valued at \$5,000. The full costs of enrollment for the successful applicant will be covered by the AMA.
