- Please list the thematic area that best align with your session topic.
  - Advocacy and Public Value
  - Operations and Organizational Sustainability
  - Adaptation and Resilience
  - Inclusion and Transformation
- How does this session address the Conference thematic areas? (200 words or less)
- Describe the intended audience for this learning opportunity. (50 words or less)
  - For example, is the session intended for entry-level, emerging, mid-career, established, or senior staff? For volunteers or board members? For small, medium, or large-sized institutions? For specific staff (e.g., curators, administrators)?
- In 25 words or less, tell us why your session is important.
- What are three discussion prompts or questions about your session? (20 words or less each)
